Audio/Video Settings for Participants

On a Windows/Mac Desktop

The attendee controls appear at the bottom of your screen if you're not currently screen sharing.



Attendees have access to these features:

Mute / Unmute: Mute and unmute your microphone.

Audio Controls (click the ^ arrow next to **Mute** / **Unmute**): Allows you to change the microphone and speaker that Zoom is currently using on your computer, leave computer audio, and access the full <u>audio settings</u>.

Tip: Use the following keyboard shortcuts to mute or unmute yourself. You can also use push to talk if you want to unmute yourself by holding the spacebar.

• Windows: Alt + A

• Mac: Shift + Command + A

Start Video / Stop Video: Turns your camera on or off.

Video Controls (click the ^ arrow next to **Start Video** / **Stop Video**): Change cameras if you have multiple cameras, select a virtual background, or access your full <u>video settings</u>.

On Android or iOS phone/tablet

The attendee controls appear at the bottom of your screen, except for Leave meeting which appears at the top-right corner.



Mute / Unmute: Mute or unmute your microphone.

Video: Start and stop your own video.
